**DIRECTIONS TO:
Mercer Oaks Golf Course**

**FROM: North & South via
Interstate 295**

Take 295 to exit 65A, Sloan Avenue. East on Sloan Avenue to first traffic light. Make a left at the first traffic light onto Quakerbridge Road. Travel 2.3 miles and make a right onto Village Road West. The entrance to Mercer Oaks Golf Course is 1.1 miles down on the right hand side.

FROM: South via U.S. #1

Cross Toll Bridge into New Jersey on U.S. 1. Make first right past Quakerbridge Mall onto Quakerbridge Road (Route 533). At the third traffic light, make left onto Village Road West. The entrance to Mercer Oaks Golf Course is 1.1 miles down on the right hand side.

FROM: North via U.S. #1

Take U.S. 1 South of Princeton to Quakerbridge Road (Route 533). Bear right off of Route 1 into jug handle, cross over Route 1 onto Quakerbridge Road. At the third traffic light, make left onto Village Road West. The entrance of Mercer Oaks Golf Course is 1.1 miles down on the right hand side.

**FROM: New Jersey
Turnpike**

Directions from NJ Turnpike:
Take exit 8 to Route 33 West to Route 130 south – 2.3miles.
Take Route 130 south to Hankins Rd. – 0.7 mile. Right onto Hankins Rd. which turns into Village Rd. East and then New Village Rd. and then Village Rd. West to Mercer Oaks – 5.4 miles on left.

Legal Fund

The following is a brief explanation of the Rules and Regulations of the Legal Fund Committee.

The Committee consists of (3) members each serving a three (3) year term. The purpose of the Legal Fund is to provide working code officials who are members of our association for at least one full year, assistance in defraying any legal expenses incurred in the defense of his/her official position. **IT IS NOT INTENDED TO PAY ALL LEGAL COSTS.** The request for assistance must be in writing to a member of the committee who will meet to evaluate the potential impact that a decision may have on code enforcement. Any denial by the committee may be

appealed to the Executive Board. If assistance is granted, a one hour meeting is scheduled with our associations attorney. The cost is paid from our attorney's retainer fee. If it is decided to proceed, the committee may pay for costs up to three thousand dollars (\$3000.00). Any additional costs will require a majority vote by both the committee and Executive Board.
